



Lions Environmental Poster Competition

The idea is to stimulate young people's interest in the environment and to provide a competition which is stimulating and interesting to them.

The Competition subject is

**LITTER
LITTER IS UNTIDY - LITTER CAN BE DANGEROUS
DON'T BE A "LITTER - BUG" TIDY UP**

Whilst it would be better if Teachers/Group Leaders did not hold a complete lesson devoted to the competition, as we really want to get a wide range of topics, here are a few suggestions that could be used to start the children's' imaginations working - Litter thrown from cars, How long Litter lasts, Effects on animals and fish, How unsightly litter is or even relating to Recycling

The competition will be open to anyone aged between 7 and 16 in 2 age groups from schools and local Youth organisations. Individuals may also enter but will not be eligible for the winning organisation prize.

- 1) 7-10 (key stage 2 years 3,4,5,& 6 in junior school)
- 2) 11-16 (Key stage 3 & 4, years 7,8,9 & 10 in senior school)

There will be two classes:

- 1) A poster using computer aided design
- 2) A poster using paint, crayons or similar as the medium

The size to be A4 (297 x 210mm or 11.7 x 8.3ins) or A3 (420 x 297mm or 16.5 x 11.7ins) Posters must be entirely the work of the nominated child and should be original i.e. they should not have previously been published or entered into other competitions.... They can contain words.

Trowbridge Lions will have the right to use the winning Posters to promote an anti Litter campaign around Trowbridge

The closing date of the competition is 31st December 2014 the subject is

LITTER

The Practical Guide



1. All entries must be accompanied by an Application Form
2. It would be better if Teachers/Leaders did not devote an entire lesson to this as the aim is to get individual ideas.
3. Each entry must be accompanied by an entry form and the declaration that it is the entirely the work of the entrant, each entry will be given a unique reference number which should be prefixed with the school or organisation name and TLC
4. All Entries will be judged by a committee made up from Trowbridge Lions Club, Trowbridge in Bloom, Trowbridge Town Council and sponsors.
5. Trowbridge Lions will provide a prize of £100 to the winning school or Youth Group for each age Group.

There will be a prize of a donation of £50 to a Local charity of the winner's choice for each age group.

There will be prizes of Book Tokens for 1st 2nd and 3rd Place

1st Place - £25

2nd Place - £15

3rd place - £10

6. The winning posters in the two age groups will then go forwarded to The Lions District competition for judging in the District competition.

Where a trophy will be awarded to the overall winners

The Roger Munday Cup for Computer Aided Designs for the older age group

The Christine Munday Cup for Computer Aided design for the younger group

The Ron Twining Cup for Traditional Posters for the older age group

The Ann Twining Cup for Traditional Posters for the younger group

In addition The Lions District will award a prize of £75 to the winning entrant in each category.

The competition starts in September with Judging in Trowbridge in December, with the winning posters going forward to Lions District competition in early 2015.
