

BY RAIL

'Bath Spa' mainline station is on the London Paddington to Bristol line. Half-hourly services run to London, a journey of approximately 90 minutes. Bristol, with connections to the Midlands, the North and the South West is a 15 minute journey. For further information, please consult the National Rail timetable or contact rail operators First Great Western, Wales & Borders Trains, Wessex Trains, Virgin Trains.

BY COACH

National Express services operate from Bath Coach Station to London Victoria and other destinations.

BY BUS

Buses 18 and 418, operated by First, depart from the city centre Bus Station (opposite Bath Spa Railway Station) approximately every 10 minutes. Return fare is £1.05. Buses 20A/20C circular routes connect the university via Weston, Twerton, Whiteway, Combe Down and Widcombe Hill.

Bus U6 is operated by Bath Bus Company from Moorland Road to the University via the Guildhall. A 2 journey ticket to the City Centre costs £1.00. All other journeys £1.20 Please Note: Bus tickets are not interchangeable between the companies.

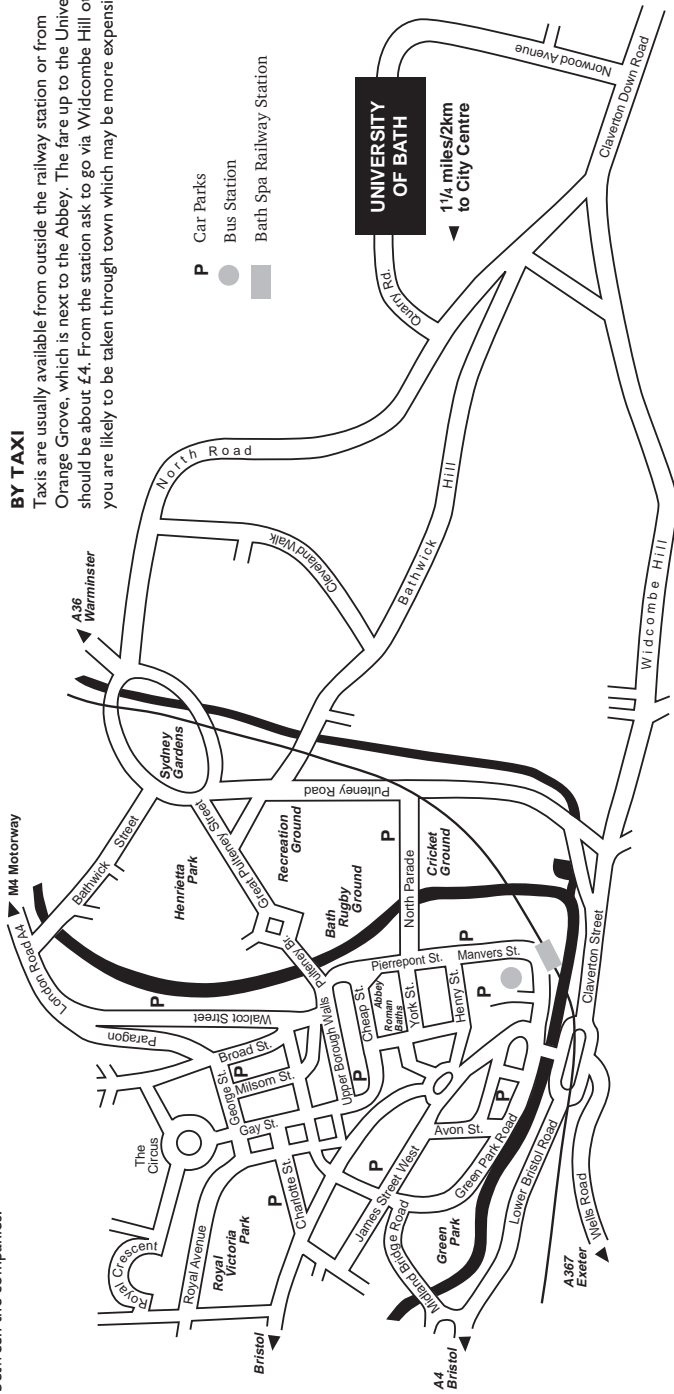
BY CAR

The University campus is situated on Claverton Down, to the east of Bath. The A4 and A36 roads run through the city; the M4 motorway is approximately 10 miles distant. If approaching from the M4, leave the motorway at junction 18 and follow the A46 south 8 miles to the Bath exit from the new dual carriageway. Turning right here brings you on to the A4 westbound to Bath. After 1.5 miles turn left at the traffic lights (signposted City Centre A36); after 700 yards turn left at the roundabout towards Warminster. In approximately 300 yards turn right into North Road (signposted Claverton Down).

The Quarry Road entrance to the campus is on the left towards the top of the hill (approximately 1 mile); the Norwood Avenue entrance is half a mile further on in Claverton Down Road. If approaching from the city centre, the A4 or the A36 eastbound follow signs to Warminster, Claverton Down, American Museum and Park & Ride (University). If approaching from the A36 (northbound) follow signs to Claverton Down.

BY TAXI

Taxis are usually available from outside the railway station or from Orange Grove, which is next to the Abbey. The fare up to the University should be about £4. From the station ask to go via Widcombe Hill otherwise you are likely to be taken through town which may be more expensive.

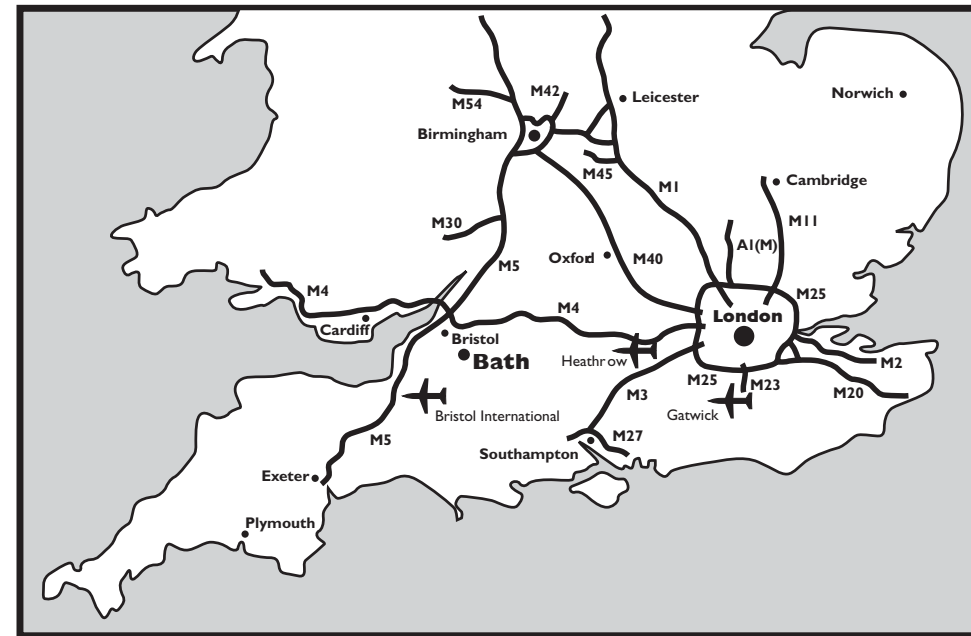

BY AIR

Bristol International Airport is the nearest to Bath and is approximately 21 miles away. An express coach service connects the airport to Bristol Temple Meads station, from where frequent trains operate to Bath. Information on travel from London Heathrow and Gatwick airports is on the web.

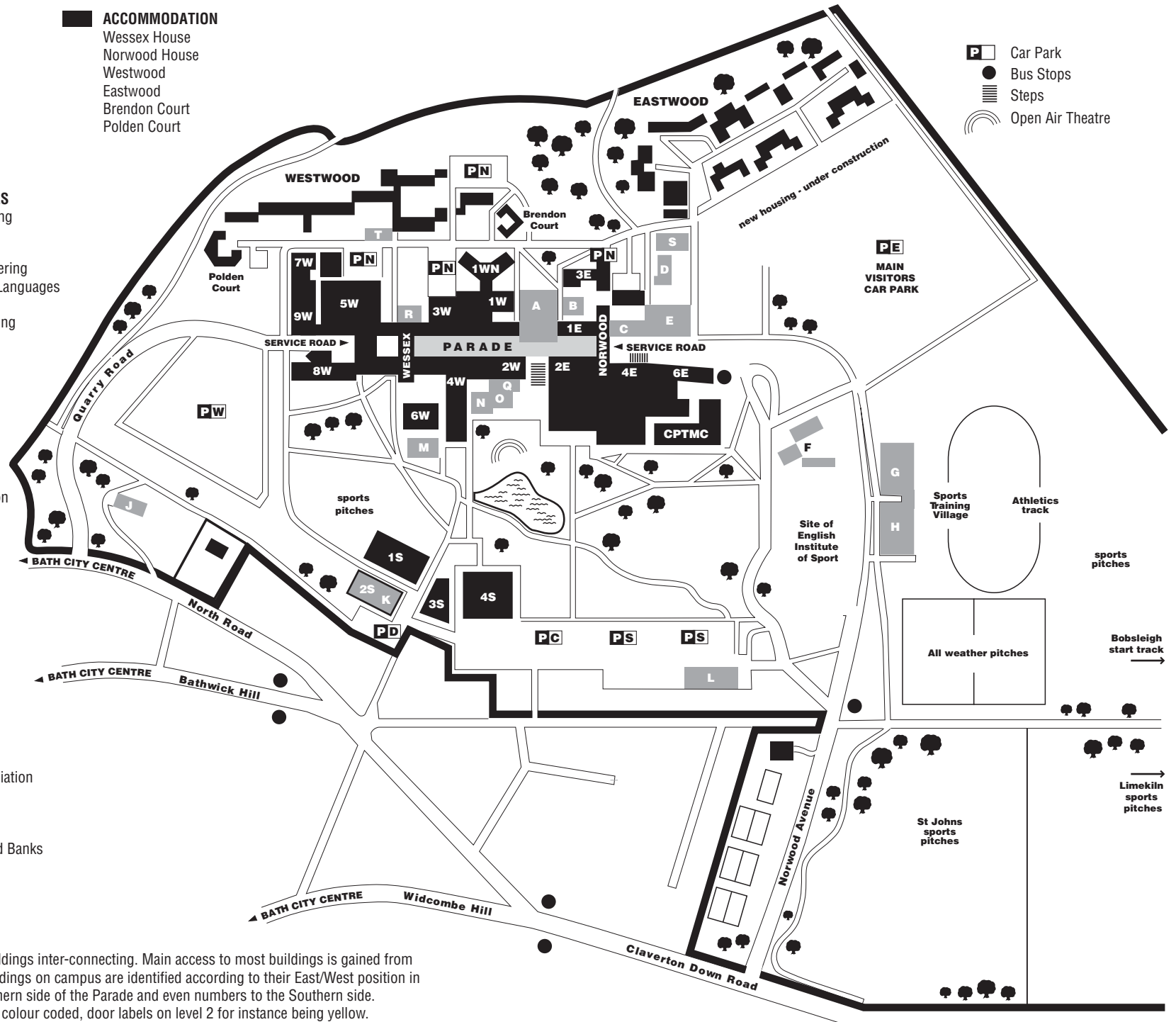

**Campus Orientation**

The campus is extremely compact, with many of the buildings inter-connecting. Main access to most buildings is gained from the Parade on level 2. Unless otherwise named, the buildings on campus are identified according to their East/West position in relation to the Library, odd numbers relating to the Northern side of the Parade and even numbers to the Southern side. To assist with orientation, levels within the buildings are colour coded, door labels on level 2 for instance being yellow.
