

<p>ENTHUSIASTIC TEACHER/TRAINER</p> <p>Role - Colleague</p> <p>Intent of Teaching - to enhance a better vision of what society can be.</p> <p>Measure of Teacher Effectiveness - getting students to act upon their visions.</p> <p>Purpose of Student Evaluation - to measure students' progress with respect to abilities.</p> <p>Concept of Knowledge - knowledge gives the student the ability to interpret and reconstruct her/his society.</p>	<p>IMAGINATIVE TEACHER/TRAINER</p> <p>Role - Faciliator</p> <p>Intent of Teaching - to further individual student growth according to the needs of each child.</p> <p>Measure of Teacher Effectiveness - facilitating student growth and development.</p> <p>Purpose of Student Evaluation - to diagnose student abilities so as to facilitate growing.</p> <p>Concept of Knowledge - knowledge give personal insights, and it derives its authority from the meaning it has to its possessor.</p>
<p>PRACTICAL TEACHER/TRAINER</p> <p>Role - Manager</p> <p>Intent of Teaching - to prepare students to perform skills they will meet in society.</p> <p>Measure of Teacher Effectiveness - efficiency in getting students to achieve skills</p> <p>Purpose of Student Evaluation - to certify to clients that students have certain skills</p> <p>Concept of Knowledge - knowledge gives the student the ability to do certain things ... capability for action</p>	<p>LOGICAL TEACHER/TRAINER</p> <p>Role - Transmitter</p> <p>Intent of Teaching - to advance students within the discipline.</p> <p>Measure of Teacher Effectiveness - accuracy in presenting the discipline.</p> <p>Purpose of Student Evaluation -to rank order students for future. advancement of the discipline.</p> <p>Concept of Knowledge - knowledge gives the student the ability to understand certain things.</p>

Advantages and Disadvantages

ENTHUSIASTIC**Advantages**

- takes risks
- gets others involved
- gets new ideas from others
- will try several options
- very active
- uses gut reactions

Disadvantages

- no organisation or goal setting
- impulsive, rushes in unawares
- so many projects or alternatives it is impossible to cope with them all
- loose ends are not always taken care of
- changability can become difficult for others to live with
- demanding of friends

IMAGINATIVE**Advantages**

- many alternative
- creative options
- can wait for the best timing
- sees things in perspective
- watching to see how others cope
- sees the potential gains
- recognises stress symptoms

Disadvantages

- waits too long before acting
- can't see the trees for the wood!
- can be frustrating to friends
- many ideas but no action
- lacks action plans
- impatient with details
- uncritical

PRACTICAL**Advantages**

- sees problems as normal and to be solved
- uses detective skills to get facts
- evaluates options
- sets up trial situations
- sets goals and acts
- works well independently

Disadvantages

- doesn't use caution in action
- task overrides people
- undervalues personal feelings
- impatient
- needs to control and do it alone
- doesn't use other people effectively

LOGICAL**Advantages**

- gathers all the facts
- organised
- reviews models and resources available to help
- reviews different alternatives
- calculates probabilities
- works well alone
- uses past experiences constructively
- looks for gains

Disadvantages

- needs too much evidence before acting
- devalues feelings of others and self
- too bogged down in theory
- takes risks slowly
- overcautious
- lets go of the past reluctantly
- fails to recognise signs of stress in self
