University of Bath Visitor's Campus Guide



Location

The University of Bath campus is situated on Claverton Down, to the east of Bath and is easily reached by road or rail.



Bus
Two Bus operators service the University: Uni Connect (blue buses - U18, 20 A/C) and First Somerset & Avon Buses (18). They all depart from Dorchester Street near the train station- approximately every 6 minutes during term and less frequently at other times. Buses 20A/20C circular routes connect the University via Weston, Twerton, Whiteway, Combe Down and Widcombe Hill. Check First's guide for ticket options or phone 0845 6064446 for more information. Car
From the North
M5 south to Bristol, M4 east to Junction 18 and A46 for 8 miles to A4 turning to Bath. Travel into Bath and turn left at traffic lights marked 'City Centre A36'. Follow the main road for 1/2 mile, turning right at the next set of main traffic lights and then left up Bathwick Hill at the next roundabout. Turn left into Norwood Avenue at the top of the hill. Park in East carpark.

From the South West
M5 north to Bristol, M4 east to Junction 18 and A46 to Bath (see above for detailed directions).

From Wales
M4 east to Junction 18 and A46 to Bath (see above for detailed directions).

From London
M4 west to Junction 18 and A46 to Bath. (see above for detailed directions).



Rail
Bath Spa Rail Station is on the main line between Bristol and London Paddington. It can be reached from the north and the south via Bristol Temple Meads. The trains run every 30 minutes to London and every 20 minutes to Bristol Temple Meads. A taxi rank is situated at the front of the Rail Station and the Bus Station is 200m along the road. 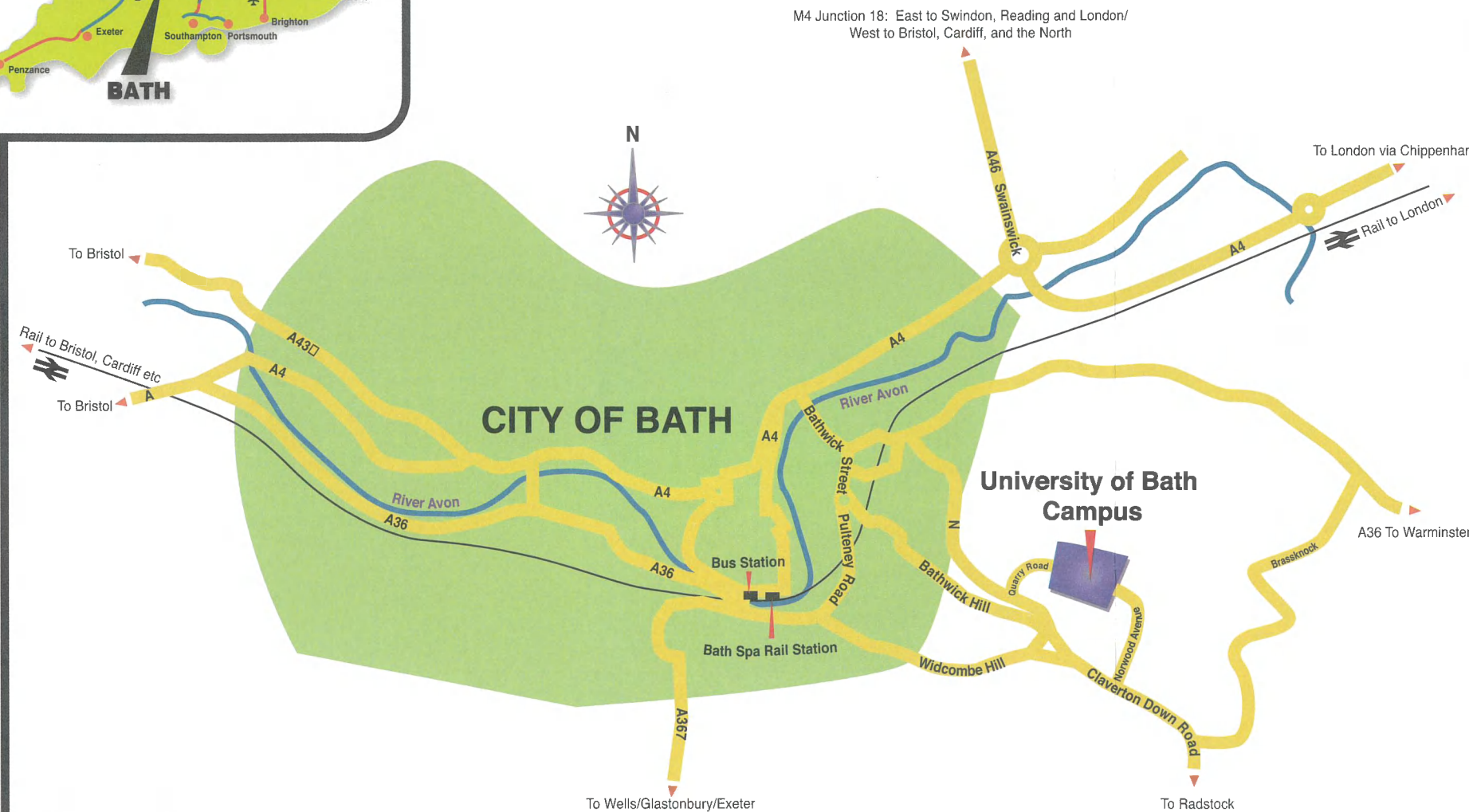


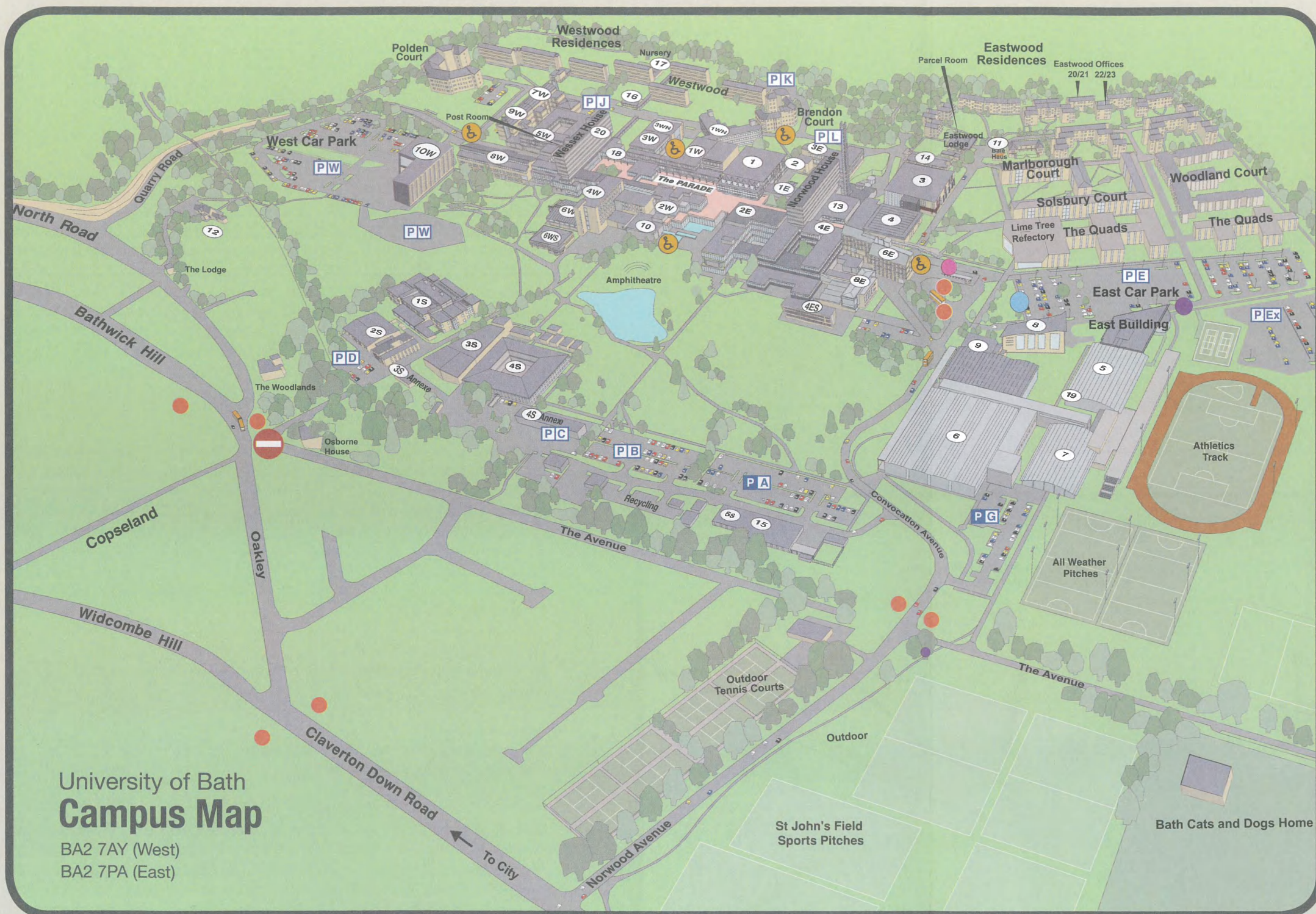
Coach

The plan of the University of Bath above will give you an idea of how the campus is laid out. The campus is compact, with many of the buildings inter-connecting. It is built around a main Parade which forms a central spine with Norwood House at the east end and Wessex House at the west end. The Library and Learning Centre is the University's central hub and all buildings are identified according to their east/west position in relation to it. Odd numbers in building names indicate that they are located on the northern side of the Parade, on the same side as the Library, and even numbers are on the southern side. The main pedestrian Parade is Level 2.

Car Parking

Car Parking at the University is limited. The Ex, A and G Car Parks have Pay & Display facilities for visitors. East car park provides disabled access to the Parade and a drop off point by 1WN also provides wheelchair access to the Parade.
